GUIDE LINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

Fusion invites original unpublished research-based papers, articles, notes, book reviews in the area of Humanities, Science, Management and inter disciplinary approaches. A general guideline for contributors is given below:-

- 1. Manuscript- The manuscript must be type written in duplicate using concise English containing 3000 to 5000 words. (6 to 10 A-4 size pages) leaving 4 cm margin on all sides of the page.
- Abstracts All the Manuscripts should include an abstract of about 250 words and key words (Maximum-6).
- Footnotes All footnotes should be indicated by serial numbers marked as superscript in the text and cited under 'Notes' at the end of the manuscript bearing corresponding numbers.
- 4. Tables and Figures The tables/Figures should be numbered in serial order of appearance (Table 1, Table 2, Figurer 1 etc.). Type each table on a separate sheet giving the corresponding table number and the table caption. Each table must include headings for all columns and rows. Figures must be drawn using black ink on separate sheet and marked with the corresponding figure number and caption at the bottom.
- 5. References References should be embedded in the text indicated by a serial number in a square bracket. Reference may also be made to the first author only along with a serial number. For example Bogardus 1940: 45 [1]. Page numbers in the text are necessary only if the cited portion is a direct quote.

Books: V.C. Pandey (2005) Anatomy of suicide, P.P.-28, Isha books, New Delhi.

Edited Book: Jones, S (2000) Contemporary existentialist thought, in M.Bradley (ed.), A History of Modern Philosophy. London: Thames Publications. P.P. 39-57.

Journals: Jones, P (2002) 'Phenomenology in Sociological theory' Journal of *Interpretative studies*, 28 (3): 202-30.

Ph.D. Thesis: Collin, J. (2001) The 'Origins of the German University System'. Ph.D. thesis, University of North town, England.

Websites: Jennings, P. (2003) An annotated bibliography of Contemporary Psychology. (Online) Available: [accessed 2nd Jan. 2003].

Book Review: Book reviews must provide the following details, and in this order: Name of author/title of book, reviewed/place of publication/publisher/year of publications, Number of Pages and Price with binding Specifications (PB or HB).

Copyright: Copyright of all publication material is vested in the Journal of Fusion. The authors shall be required to sign a copy right transfer form before publication.
